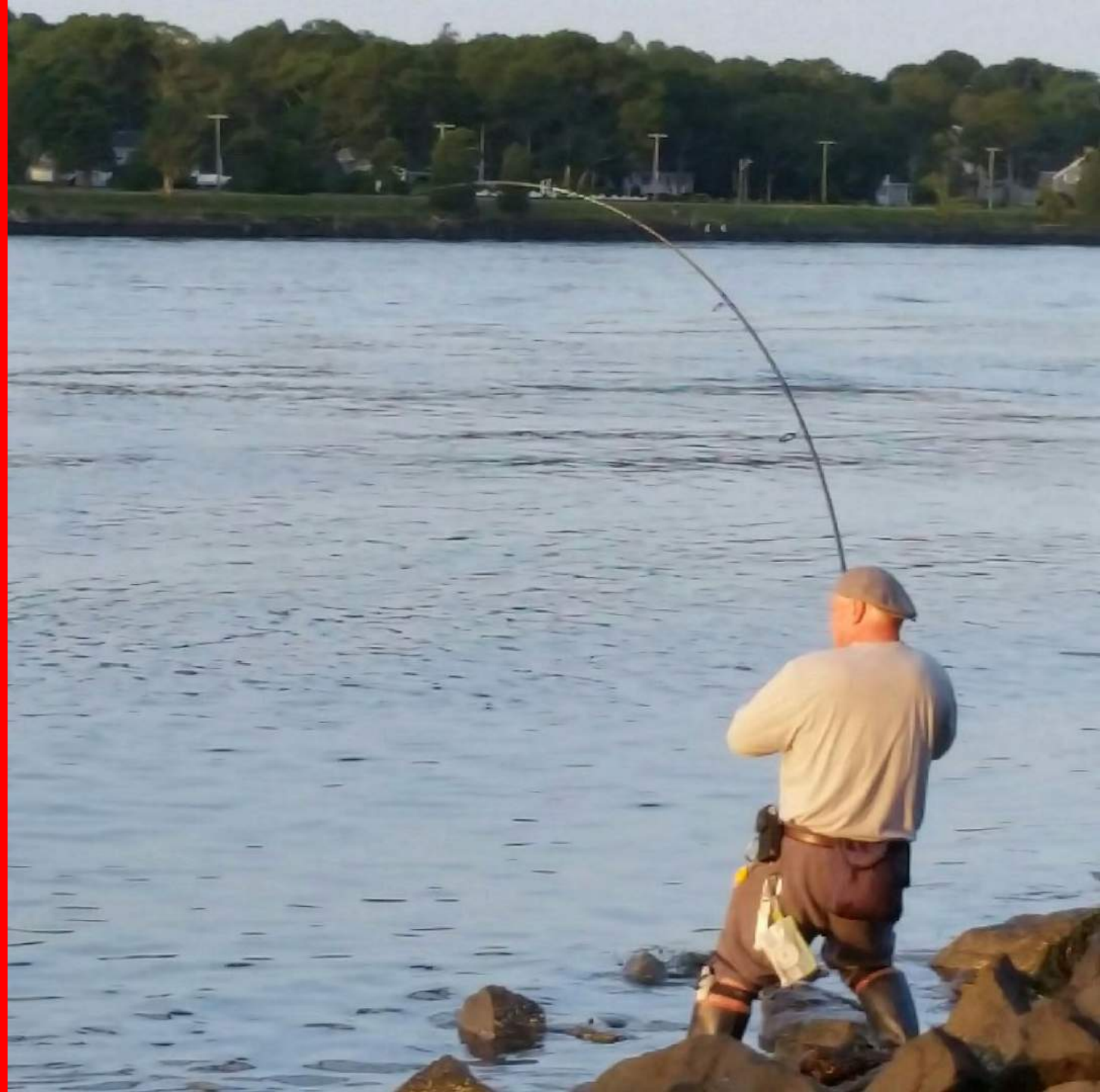

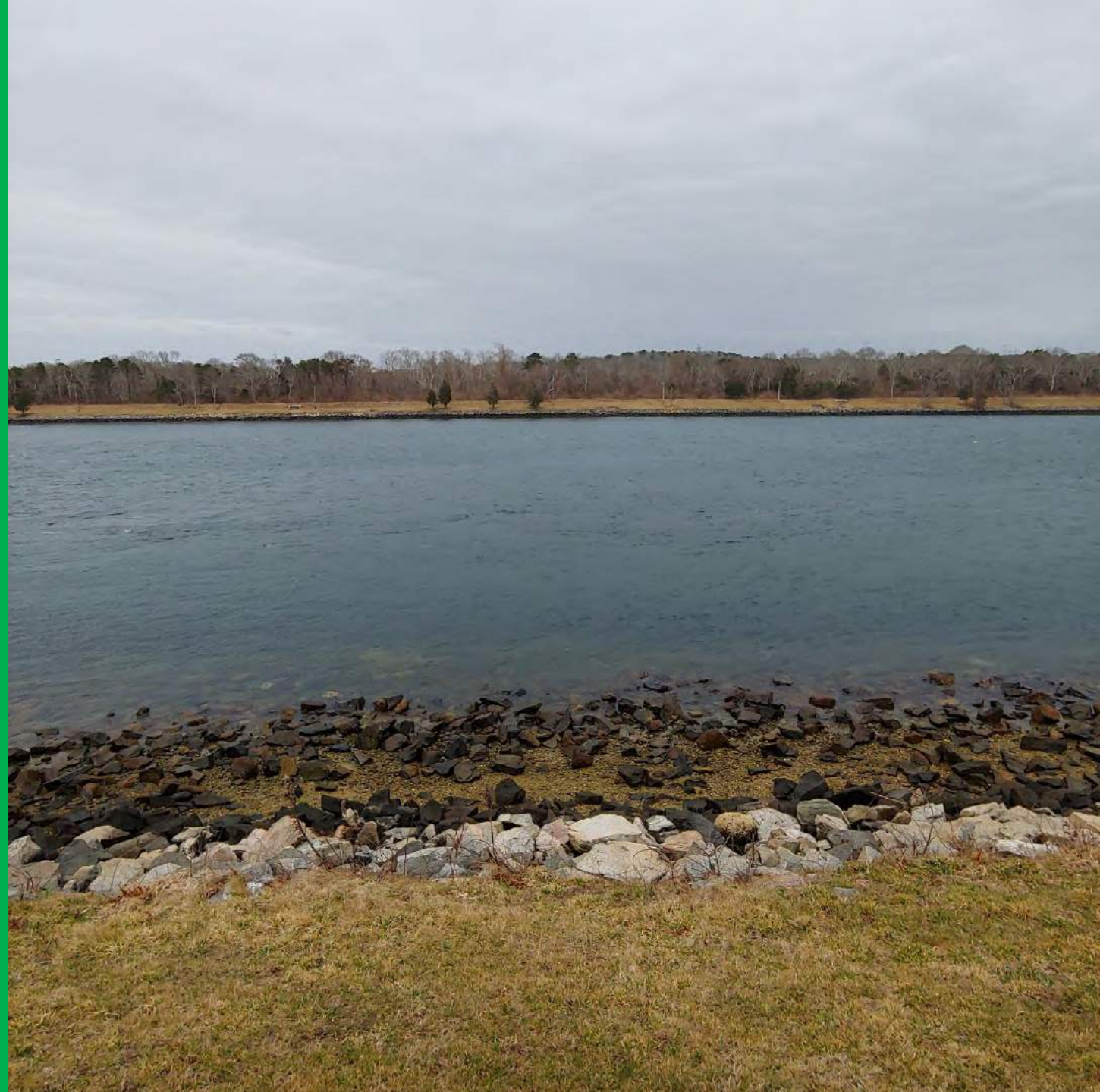

– lobster pots, rocks

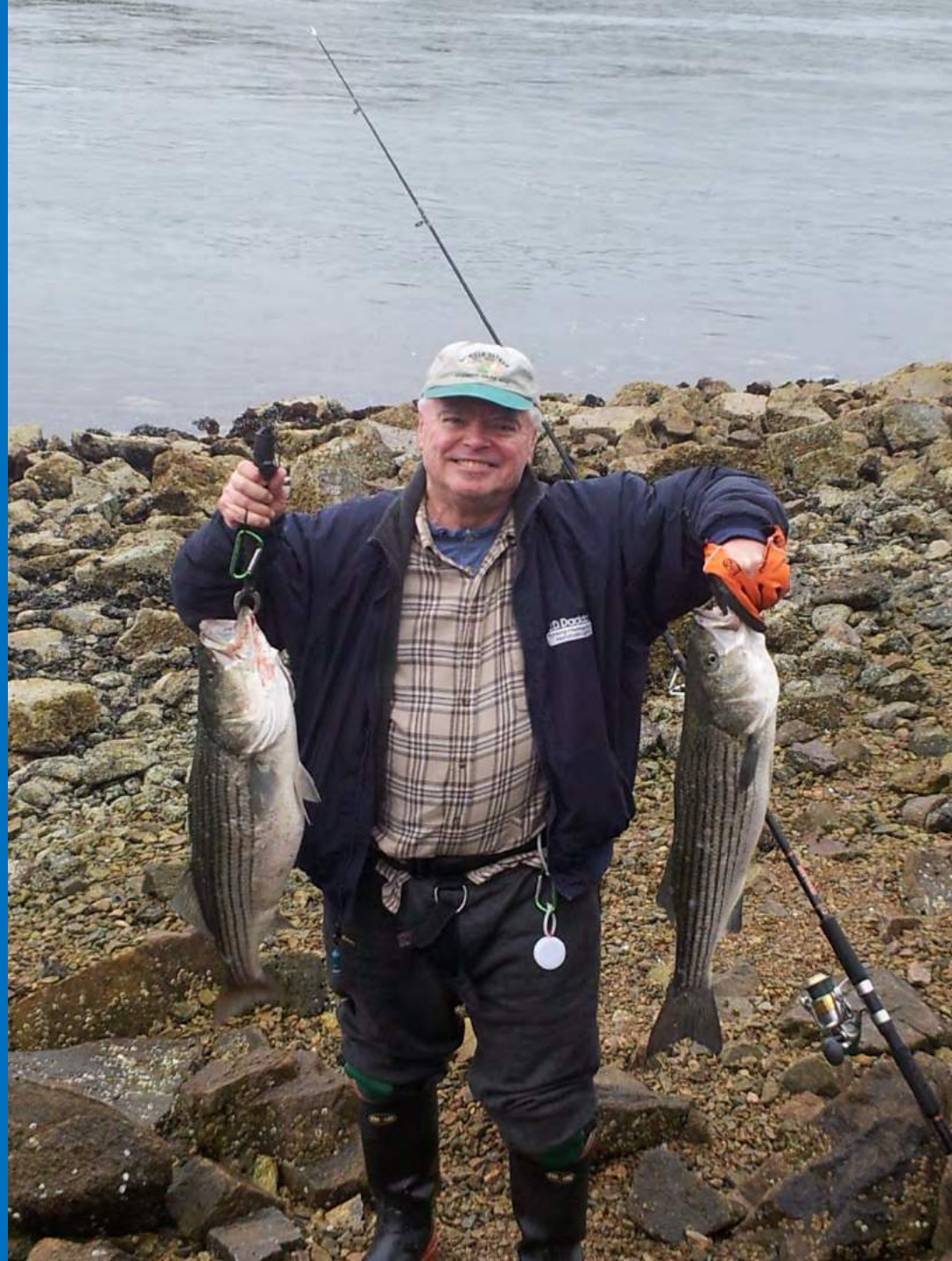


Best Time - Breaking Tide

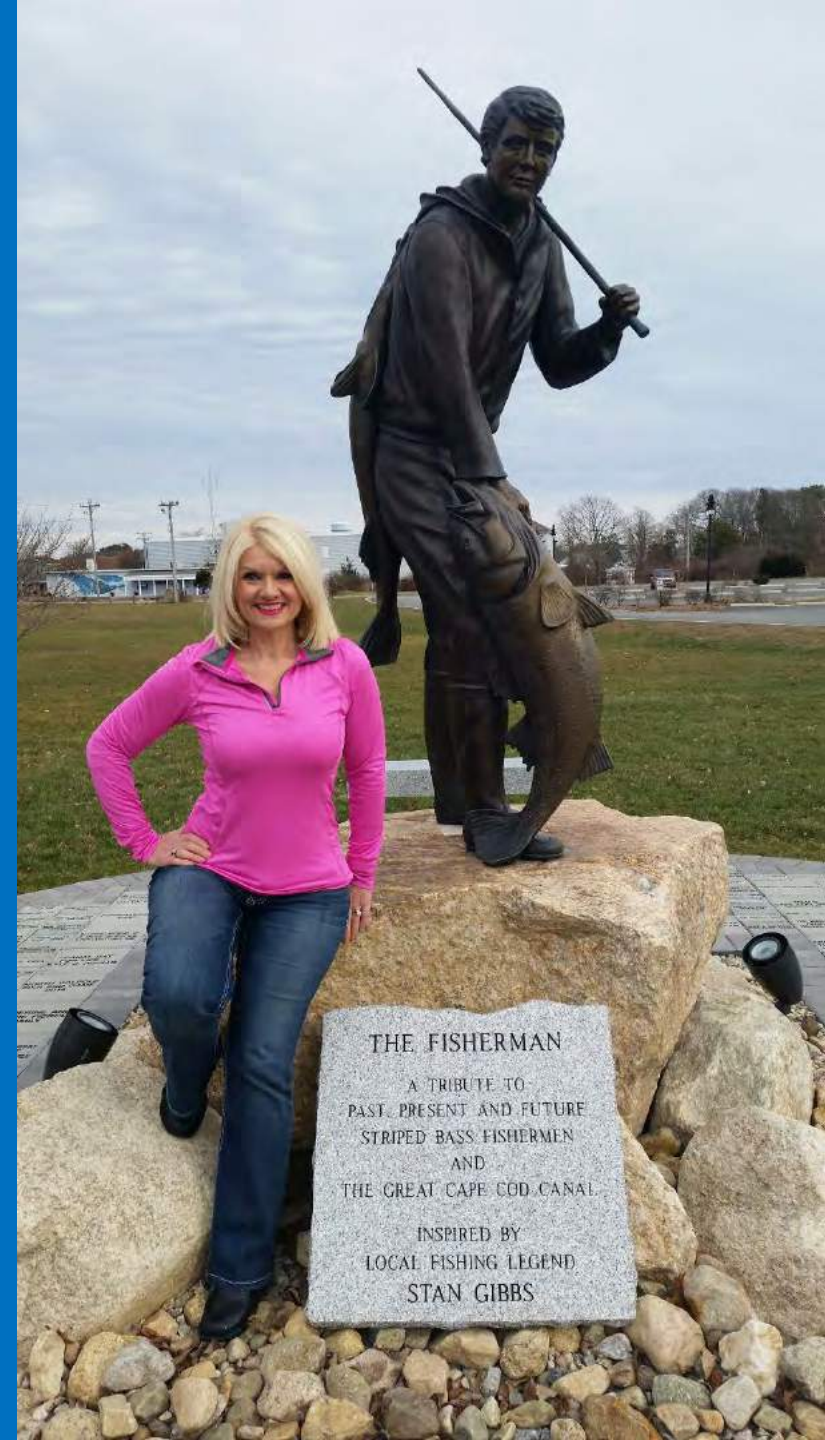
